Playing Full-out in Faith

And he said, "Just as you have believed, let it be done to you."

– MATTHEW 9:29

As spiritual beings having human experiences, we are called to live faithfully to the truth of our being. And in faith, believing in our individual and collective divinity, we are called to play the game of life full-out. Although this is simple, it is not easy to do. It requires us to:

- Bring focused awareness to our heart's desire, not yet manifested but fully forming in mind.
- Wholly believe our desires can become real and now are manifested.
- Dismiss doubt and fear; their habitual devastation does not diminish our sense of worthiness.
- Engage faith as more definite and concrete than any doubt or fear.
- Stand in a faith so irrepressible that it cannot be shaken by a prognosis, delay, no-show, lay-off, rejection or another's opinion.

Ernest Holmes reminds us, "Faith is a mental attitude that is so convinced of its own idea — that so completely accepts it — that any contradiction is unthinkable and impossible. The barriers between you and your greater good are not barriers in themselves. They are things of thought. It is because of this that all things are possible to faith."

Rather than focusing on would-be barriers, deny them. Stand fast in knowing the Divine has no barriers. Recognize there is that within and around each of us always providing the ideal breakthrough. To stand in faith means we assume a position similar to Yeshua's when he declared, "Father, I know Thou hearest me always." We, too, must know we are guided by divine wisdom and that our thought has tremendous transformative power.

It has been said that Yeshua's key message can be synthesized as: "It is done unto you as you believe." This impartation of divine wisdom can be radically transformative — a game changer!

Something will always challenge your faith. Trust that there is something greater than your circumstances. The only question is whether you *believe* this. It is done unto you as you believe. #
